

# The Companies and Limited Liability Partnerships (Miscellaneous Amendments) Act took effect on 16 June 2025



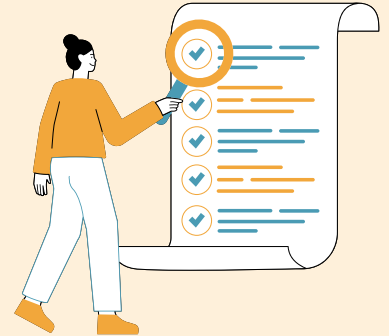
## What You Need To Know

### 01

#### Register of Registrable Controllers (RORC)

New companies, foreign companies and Limited Liability Partnerships are required to set up and keep an RORC from the date of incorporation or registration, unless they are exempted.

#### Registers of Nominee Directors and Nominee Shareholders

Local companies and foreign companies must file information in their private Registers of Nominee Directors and Nominee Shareholders with the ACRA Central Registers of Nominee Directors and Nominee Shareholders unless they are exempted.



**Please do so by 31 December 2025.**

The nominee status of directors and shareholders will be publicly available. However, information on the particulars of nominators in ACRA's Central Registers will only be accessible to law enforcement agencies.

#### Increased Penalties

Non-compliance with requirements to keep registers and file information with ACRA may result in prosecution and fines of up to \$25,000.
