



From 1 Oct, businesses can manage the filing and access rights of their Registered Filing Agents, through the BizFile⁺ Dashboard.

SMEs can now sign up for SMECEN via Business Related Services in BizFile⁺. SMECEN is a cloud-based integrated software providing accounting, HR and compliance modules to make filing to ACRA, IRAS and CPF easy for SMEs.



Application for Licences Made Easy

From 31 Oct, once a business owner successfully registers his business in BizFile⁺, he will be guided to the new GoBusiness Licensing portal to apply for the licences required to operate his business. The new portal, which replaces the current LicenceOne portal, will also feature a Guided Journey for entrepreneurs who want to operate a business in the food and beverage sector.
