The DCP is aimed at directors as identified by ACRA, who have failed to comply with the annual return filing requirements under the Companies Act. Existing business entities registered with ACRA will receive a free copy of their Business Profile after successfully renewing their business registration, or filing their Annual Returns or Annual Declarations.

Using the **Entity Search** function in ACRA's BizFile⁺ portal, the public can now access information on business entities such as business activity (SSIC), filing history, validity of the registered business address and even locate a business address on an online map.
