Updated Guidelines for Corporate Service Providers

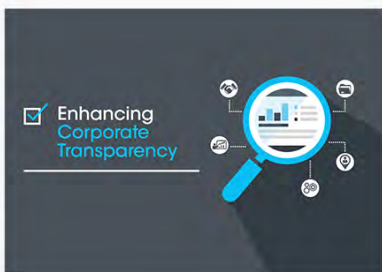
The Guidelines for Registered Filing Agents (RFA) have been updated to better guide RFAs in complying with regulatory requirements under the enhanced regulatory regime for Corporate Service Providers (CSPs). Key updates include enhancing the guidance on risk assessments of RFAs, identifying beneficial owners and other customer due diligence (CDD) measures, as well as relevant findings gleaned from ACRA's inspection of CSPs.

Get More Useful Business Info: Free Business Search Function in BizFile+

ACRA's Directory Search Function in the BizFile+ portal now provides even more free information on over 500,000 business entities. In addition to basic information such as status and address of the entity, the search results also indicate registered office address that have not been updated. It also shows if companies that are required to file their financial statements with ACRA, have done so in the last three years.
